- Provide evidence of your continued sporting performance in accordance to the criteria set out above. This must be in the form of a letter of support from your Governing Body of Sport. If still eligible you will receive your new membership card within two weeks.

# Moray Gold Card Scheme

## Mission Statement

The Moray Gold Card Scheme is an initiative which aims to provide National and International level performers the support and encouragement they require to help them reach their full potential.

## Aim

To provide free access to a number of the area's sport and leisure facilities at appropriate times for personal training and development.

## Eligibility

The scheme will provide opportunities to sports people who currently perform at national level or above.

## Criteria

1. Currently a member of National/International Squad
2. Sport must be recognised by sportscotland
3. Must reside in Moray

If you meet the above criteria you could be eligible for a Moray Gold Card. Evidence of confirmation of your involvement at national or international level will be required from the Governing Body of the sport.

## **Operational Guidelines**

1. Each Moray Gold Card member will be entitled to free use of facilities at the convenience of the facility manager, when open, provided there is no disruption to other users and no additional cost is incurred: eg floodlighting.

2. Moray Gold Card members will be allowed a maximum of three visits to a facility per week.
3. Membership of the Moray Gold Card Scheme is renewable every twelve months, pending continued sports performance at National/International level.
4. Members are responsible for ensuring that the use of facilities is both safe and appropriate.
5. Once you have received your Moray Gold Card you should contact your specific facility to discuss practical arrangements for use.
6. The facilities available through this scheme include Buckie Leisure Centre, Forres Swimming Pool and Fitness Centre, Keith Sports and Community Centre, Lossiemouth Swimming Pool and Speyside Swimming Pool. Moray Council grass pitches and tennis courts are also included within the scheme.
