2010 RECOGNITION AWARDS

INTRODUCTION

sportMoray's Recognition Awards were introduced in 1999 to recognise individuals and teams who have contributed or achieved a great deal in their chosen sport at either recreational, regional, national or international level. There are nine categories of awards that individuals/teams can be nominated for and these are as follows;

SALSC Local Service to Sport Award	This award is for an individual administrator, coach or official for their voluntary contribution to local sport over a lengthy period of time (e.g. minimum of 10 Years). Sponsor is the Scottish Association of Local Sports Councils.
Junior Sportsman Award	This award is for a male sports person who has achieved excellence at either a regional, national or international level. Must be aged between 12-18 Years on 30 Nov 2010. Sponsor is Moray College.
Junior Sportswoman Award	This award is for a female sports person who has achieved excellence at either a regional, national or international level. Must be aged between 12- 18 years on 30 Nov 2010. Sponsor is Moray Council.
Junior Team Award	This award is for a team that has achieved excellence at either a regional, national or international level. Team must be made up of players under the age of 18 at 30 November 2010. Sponsor is The Northern Scot.
Senior Team Award	This award is for a team that has achieved excellence at either regional, national or international level. Sponsor is The Moray Leisure Centre.
Coach Award	This award is for an individual who has contributed locally to the development of sport through coaching at their chosen level. Sponsor is sportMoray.
Club Level Award	This award is for an individual sports person who has made a valuable contribution at club level. Sponsor is Diageo.
Special Achievement Award	This special award will be given to an individual who has attained an outstanding personal achievement in sport through overcoming adversity. Sponsor is Elgin Rotary Club.
Sports Person of the Year	This award is for an individual who has achieved excellence at a regional, national or international level. Nominees for this award must be over 18 years of age. Sponsor is Campbell and McConnachie Financial Consultants.

Winners of each category will also be nominated by sportMoray to current National Awards.

Criteria

1. Individuals or clubs may submit nominations for one or more categories.
2. A nominee can only be entered up to a maximum of two categories.
3. Nominations must be proposed and seconded.
4. Nominations should be for sporting achievements attained during the period November 2009 to November 2010.
5. Nominations will only be considered for individuals/teams resident in the Moray area.
6. Individuals who have made their contribution as part of paid employment will be exempt.
7. A panel from sportMoray will be selected to identify category winners. The decision of this panel is final.
8. Nominations will only be accepted for sports recognised by sportscotland.
9. Up to six nominations for each award will be shortlisted.
10. Completed nomination forms and supporting information should be returned no later than Thursday 4th November.
11. It is requested that applicants also submit footage/photographs via email/cd/disc of individuals/teams nominated in action for their sport. This will be used if shortlisted at the Awards evening.
